

Travel information: Getting from Naples Airport to Sorrento

Naples International Airport (Capodichino, NAP) is located about 50 km north of Sorrento. Travelers can choose between a direct bus, a public-transport combination, a private transfer/taxi, or (seasonally) a ferry via the port of Naples. This guide compares all options.

Option 1 — Curreri Viaggi Direct Bus

The only bus company running a **direct** service from the airport straight to Sorrento, with no transfers.

- **Departure point:** Outside the Arrivals terminal, signposted "Curreri Sorrento" (look for parking area P1 outside the terminal)
- **Arrival point:** Sorrento, at the train station (Piazza Lauro / Circumvesuviana station), a short walk from Piazza Tasso
- **Travel time:** Approx. 75–90 minutes (traffic-dependent)
- **Frequency:** About 8 departures per day, roughly every 1–1.5 hours, from around 9:00 AM to 7:30 PM
- **Cost:** €10 one-way (approx. €18 return); tickets can be bought from the driver or in advance online
- **Luggage:** One standard hold bag + one carry-on included
- **Booking:** Not required; you can pay on board, but advance online booking is available via curreriviaggi.it

Option 2 — Public Transport: Alibus + Circumvesuviana Train

The budget-friendly, multi-step public transit route.

- **Alibus shuttle: Airport → Napoli Centrale train station (Piazza Garibaldi)**

- Cost: €5
- Duration: ~20–30 minutes
- Frequency: Every 15–30 minutes, roughly 6:00 AM–11:40 PM

- **Circumvesuviana train: Napoli Centrale → Sorrento (last stop on the line)**

- Cost: approx. €4 (regular Circumvesuviana) or ~€15 for the faster Campania Express (fewer stops, reserved seating)
- Duration: Regular train ~70–75 minutes; Campania Express ~50 minutes
- Frequency: Every 20–30 minutes

Total cost: Roughly €9–10 (regular train) or ~€20 (with Campania Express) **Total time:** Around 1.5–2 hours, including the connection at Napoli Centrale

Option 3 — Private Transfer or Taxi

- **Private pre-booked transfer:**

- Cost: approx. €80–150 for a sedan (up to 3–4 passengers); minivans for larger groups cost more
- Duration: 50–70 minutes, direct to your hotel
- Booking: Must be arranged in advance (online, via hotel, or a local transfer company); flight tracking and a driver with a name sign are usually included
- A night supplement (roughly +€20–30) may apply for arrivals between 8:00 PM and 7:00 AM

- **Airport taxi rank:**

- Naples airport taxis do not run on a fixed meter fare to Sorrento (unlike the fixed in-city zone fares), so always confirm the price with the driver before departure
- Typical fare: roughly €100–160, depending on time of day and negotiation
- Taxi stand: Located just outside the Arrivals exit

Option 4 — Ferry via Naples Port

A scenic alternative, though it requires getting into Naples city first.

- **Alibus: Airport → Molo Beverello port (Naples)**

- Cost: €5, ~30–40 minutes depending on traffic

- **High-speed ferry/hydrofoil: Molo Beverello → Port of Sorrento (operated by Alilauro or NLG)**

- Cost: approx. €16–18 one-way
- Duration: ~40–45 minutes
- Multiple daily departures, but service can be suspended in rough sea conditions

Total cost: Roughly €21–23. **Total time:** Around 1.5–2 hours, including the Alibus connection

Quick Comparison

Option	Cost (per person)	Travel Time	Convenience
Curreri direct bus	€10	75–90 min	Good (direct, no transfer, fixed schedule)
Alibus + Circumvesuviana	€9–20	1.5–2 hrs	Cheapest, but involves a transfer and can be crowded
Private transfer	€80–150	50–70 min	Best (door-to-door, no waiting, fixed price)
Airport taxi	~€100–160	50–70 min	Convenient but price not fixed, negotiate first

Practical Tips

- **Booking the Curreri bus in advance is not necessary** — tickets are sold on board — but it guarantees a seat during busy periods (peak summer, holidays).
- **If your flight arrives late at night**, the Alibus and Circumvesuviana stop running around midnight; after that, a private transfer or taxi is your only option.
- **Traveling with lots of luggage or with small children** favors the private transfer, since the Curreri bus and Circumvesuviana can get crowded and have limited space.
- **Always verify current schedules and prices** before travel, as they can change seasonally — check curreriviaggi.it for the bus and trenitalia.it / eavsrl.it for the Circumvesuviana/Campania Express.
